QUEENS CONTEST INFORMATION

Contest Date: Saturday, JULY 2, 2022 at Barney Wiggins Memorial Arena

Sweetheart Contest – Ages 13 - 15

Queens Contest – Ages 16 - 19

Interviews: Start at 10:00 am, must check in by 9:45 am in Hospitality Room

Horsemanship: Start at 3:00 pm or as close to 3 pm as possible after interviews and break for lunch - Two (2) patterns will be judged; the 1st pattern will be the practiced pattern and the 2nd will be one of the other patterns given in your packet and will be posted at the arena on July 2nd.

Practice Nights: Required 1 of the 2 scheduled times. All horses will be validated on your practice night. You must practice on the horse that you will be on to compete. Any questions regarding practice will need to be addressed before the first practice date.

Tuesday, June 21, 2022 at 6:30 pm and Monday, June 27th at 6:30 pm

ATTIRE: Attire for both the interview and riding will be a long-sleeve white western shirt, black jeans or slacks, boots, and hat (hat for interview is optional).

INTERVIEW REQUIREMENTS: 40% of total score. You will be asked to give a short introduction (1-2 minutes) about yourself before questions are asked. Standardized Interview type questions and general horse knowledge questions will be asked.

HORSEMANSHIP: 60% of total score. Chaps are optional. Contestants will be required to complete two patterns. One horsemanship pattern that will be given to you at our practices and one pattern chosen from the other patterns that contestants will be given at practice and will be posted the morning of interviews.

RESULTS: Results will be tallied by the judges and winners will be announced as soon as possible after riding is complete. We will have two judges for interview and horsemanship. The Queen and Sweetheart will receive the buckle crowns on July 6, 2022, before the Rodeo starts at 7 pm. The Royalty Court will need to be at the Arena ready to ride by 6:15 pm on July 6th. The 2021 reigning Queen and Sweetheart will carry the American and Texas flags on July 6th, the 2021 and 2022 Royalty Court will be responsible for the flags during the other nights of the rodeo. All 2022 winners must attend the Rodeo July 6 through July 9, 2022.
